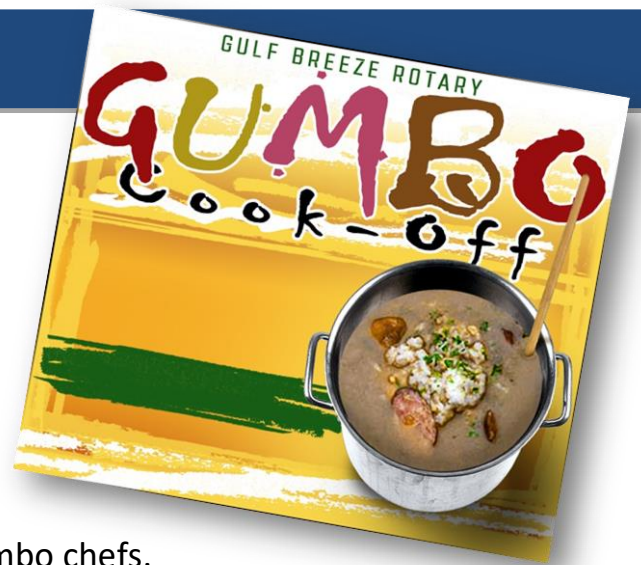


COOKING TEAM REGISTRATION

Gumbo Team Details

- **Entry Fee is \$100 – NO FEE for licensed restaurants.**
 - Paying teams receive 10 event tickets to sell or give away (\$100 value).
All teams receive 4 event tickets and 8 beverage tickets for team members (\$64 value).
 - Each team must **cook 15 gallons of gumbo** on site at the event, and **serve from 11 a.m. to 3 p.m.**
 - Rice, bowls & spoons are provided.
 - Booth decorations are encouraged.
- Prizes awarded in Professional and Amateur Divisions for 1st, 2nd, 3rd and People's Choice 1st

GUMBO TEAM INFORMATION

Day of Event

- All Chefs on team **must** wear wristbands.
- Gumbo must be cooked on site and ready to serve by 11 a.m.
- Serve from 11 a.m. to 3 p.m.
- Make sure hands and cooking utensils are washed and sanitized at all times.
- Chefs must wear gloves while preparing food.
- Gumbo must be 160 degrees to serve.
- Empty all trash into trash cans and keep area clean.
- Please drink all beverages in a cup - no visible beer bottles or cans.
- Each team is allowed to bring their own beverages; however, Gulf Breeze Rotary will be selling beer, so you are not allowed to sell beer or alcoholic beverages to the general public.
- No live animals or pets.
- ABSOLUTELY NO SMOKING IN THE PARK.

Each team will need to bring the following:

- Box or can with liner for trash
- Cutting board
- Knives and other cooking utensils
- Can openers
- 10 to 15 gallon pot
- Propane burner and propane
- Main ingredient (chicken, seafood, sausage)
- All ingredients except rice
- Extra towels, bowls and paper towels
- Spray cleaner, i.e. Lysol, 409, etc.
- Hand sanitizer

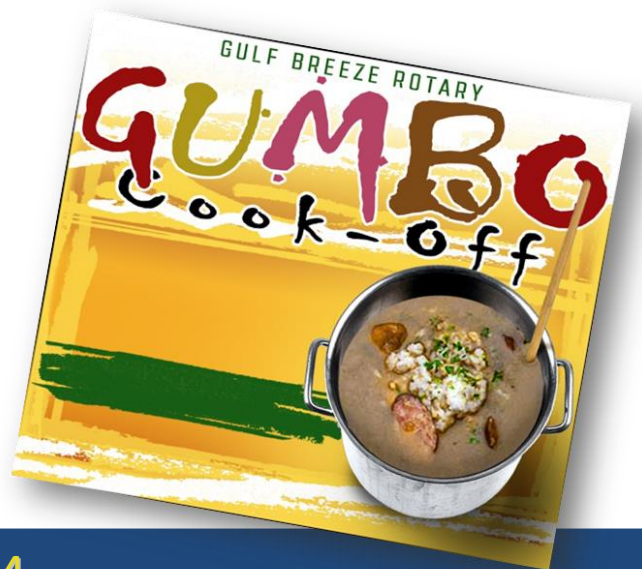
Sequence of Events
